Since joining the IWU faculty in the fall of 2016, he has appeared in concert with IWU students as the vocal coach and harpsichordist in *The Marriage of Figaro*; at the piano with the IWU Symphony Orchestra; and as part of the Symposium of Contemporary Music. Andrew holds a M.M. in Collaborative Piano from the Cleveland Institute of Music, and dual bachelor degrees in piano and voice from Northern Illinois University. His credits as a performer include coaching and performance positions with the CIM Opera Theater, Great Lakes Light Opera, Dramatic Crossroads Opera, Interlochen Center for the Arts, and Chicago Summer Opera, as well as accompanist work at Case Western Reserve University, Cleveland State University, and Ursuline College.
